## Horse Leaders at NVTRP Policies/Guidelines

## Required:

- 1. Attend a Volunteer Intro Training Session
- 2. Complete a Horse Experience Questionnaire (HEQ)
- 3. Actively volunteer on a weekly scheduled shift
- 4. Successful completion of a Horse Leader Workshop (HLW) (\*Please note: submission of the HEQ does not guarantee an invitation to a HLW)
- 5. Following completion of the HLW, all volunteers will start out leading horses in the barn area **ONLY**. Leaders for client sessions will be chosen at the discretion of the instructors/therapists.

## Recommended:

- 1. 2 years or more of horse experience (i.e. riding, barn help, etc.)
- 2. 12 or more NVTRP volunteer hours
- 3. 8 or more NVTRP sidewalking hours

## Note:

- 1. If you are a returning Horse Leader and have not volunteered within 12 months, you must attend a HLW to reinstate leading responsibilities.
- 2. All horse leaders must act in a professional manner and within the NVTRP guidelines for horsemanship.
- 3. NVTRP reserves the right to suspend leading responsibilities (or allow leading of specific horses only) at any time for reasons that include, but are not limited to: safety risks, inappropriate behavior, leading technique, misconduct, horse/client needs.
- 4. Client session and Hippotherapy leaders are chosen at the discretion of the therapist and instructor.
